John 6:64 - Jesus knows our motivation


John 6:66-71 - Jesus filtered until only 11 people remained


1. What is the Lord's Supper?


It is a symbolic way to remember the Sacrifice of Christ - 1 Corinthians 11:26

2. How often should we do the Lord's Supper?

The frequency is not determined in the Bible, but it should be taken regularly.

- 3. We are called to examine ourselves prior to taking the Lord's Supper.
 - 1 Corinthiens 11:27-32.
 - a. Am I a believer?
 - b. Am I an obedient, baptized disciple?
 - c. Do I have a right relationship with others? Matthew 6:14-15
 - d. Do I have a right relationship with God? 1 John 1:9
- 4. Who can administer the Lord's Supper?Any obedient, baptized disciple of Christ.






LESSON 1: THE HEAD - ROMANS 12:4-5

b. The Deacons


- i. Their roles: the Service Acts 6:1-8


- 1. Qualities of a good leader 1 Peter 5:1-5
 - a. He leads voluntarily.
 - b. He leads to build the kingdom of God.
 - c. He does not abuse his power.
 - d. He manifests these qualities to enable new leaders to learn from him.
- 2. The good leader prepares and strengthens new leaders He must:
 - a. Model Allow others to watch as you lead and teach.
 - b. Assist Help them do what you have taught them.
 - c. Watch Observe as they lead and gently correct their errors.
 - d. Launch Release them so they can train other potential leaders.
